ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

SAINT LEO UNIVERSITY AND BRISTOL COMMUNITY COLLEGE

I. SCOPE AND PURPOSE

- A. Articulated Programs. Saint Leo University (SLU) and Bristol Community College (BCC) hereby enter into the following articulation agreement governing the matriculation of the Associate in Science graduates of Bristol Community College into Saint Leo University Baccalaureate of Art and Baccalaureate of Science degree programs
- B. Purpose. It is the intention of this articulation agreement to facilitate a seamless transition from the Associate in Science at Bristol Community

College to Baccalaureate programs at Saint Leo either at one of the SLU campuses or through the Center for Online Learning.

C. Understanding of the parties.

For all Bristol Community College Associate in Science graduates admitted to Saint Leo University during the term of this agreement, Saint Leo University will:

- a. Accept the students as having junior standing, with the understanding that students may need to complete certain general education courses and prerequisite courses for the program in which they enroll.
- b. Accept maximum hours transferred (64 semester hours); minimum hours in major with SLU (15 semester hours); minimum residence requirement with SLU (30 semester hours); total hours needed to graduate from SLU (minimum 120 semester hours).
- c. Accept coursework as transferable to Saint Leo University on a course by course basis as applied to meet general education and electives degree requirements.
- d. Accept transfer credit for courses in which a "D" grade was given.
- D. Severability. If, for any reason, any provision of this agreement is held invalid, all other provisions of this agreement shall remain in effect. If this agreement in whole is held invalid or cannot be enforced, then to the fullest extent permitted by law, any prior agreement between the parties shall be deemed reinstated as if this agreement had not been executed.

Article 1 – Termination

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon at least ninety (90) days written notice given by either party.

This agreement shall continue in effect for five (5) years from the date indicated above, unless terminated by either party in writing of their desire to have it terminated. The agreement and understanding that termination will not be executed without a negotiated teach-out agreement for students currently enrolled.

Article 2 – Acceptance by Parties

The parties are committed to the concept of a long-standing agreement. This agreement will be amended when Articles are added, deleted, or significantly modified. Amendments must be in writing and may take the form of letters signed by the
