Special Articulation Program Between Raritan Valley Community College and Kean University's New Jersey Center for Science and Technology Education

This special articulation agreement was designed to allow a Raritan Valley Community College (RVCC) student who earns an A.S. Biotechnology transfer program degree (ONLY) to transfer and matriculate into the Kean University's combined degree program leading to a B.S. Science and Technology/Molecular Biology and a M.S. Science and Technology/Biotechnology. The student will need to have earned passing credit (grade of C or better) for the following RVCC courses: a computer language course (either CIS103 or CIS 105), calculus I, calculus II, statistics I, organic chemistry I and II and genetics. Additionally, students must meet the current admission criteria outlined by the New Jersey Center for Science and Technology Education at Education at Kean University (see njcste.kean.edu). If students do not maintain a 3.0 G.P.A. at Kean University, they will need to change their major program and have their transfer credits evaluated under the new program. Please check of RVCC on the application and indicate Science and Technology as the major choice.
