## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Averett University Transfer Guide is to assist admissions counselors at Averett and transfer counselors at the Virginia community colleges in advising prospective transfer students. Averett welcomes qualified transfer applicants from the Virginia Community College System and will do everything possible to aid these students in making a smooth transition to our university. To assist in this transition, Averett accepts the transfer module as partial fulfillment of the general education requirements and has established a cooperative transfer policy for Virginia Community College System graduates.

Averett University is accredited by the Commission on College of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, GA, telephone (404-679-4501).

## **COOPERATIVE TRANSFER AGREEMENT WITH THE VIRGINIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM**

The following policies govern an associate degree holder from a Virginia Community College: Any student who completes the Associate in Arts, Associate in Science or Associate in Arts and Science degree from a Virginia Community College System institution will be admitted to Averett University with junior status. Students who complete an Associate in Applied Science degree will be admitted as juniors if they are pursuing the Bachelor of Applied Science degree. Students who complete the Associate in Applied Science degree in Administration of Justice, or its equivalent, will be admitted as juniors to pursue the Bachelor of Science degree in the "2+2" program, Sociology/Criminal Justice.

All courses applying to the degree from the community college will be accepted in transfer at Averett University; however, Averett does not accept the grade of D in ENG 111, 112 or their equivalents.

If a student does not have an associate degree, then the transfer courses will be evaluated individually. All rules for transferring courses, as stated in the

Catalog and Transfer Guidelines, will be applied. The procedures for transferring credits to Averett are listed in the Averett University catalog.

### **TRANSFER STUDENTS**

1. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 60 semester hours at a senior college, at least 33 of which must be from Averett University. Twelve of the 33 hours taken at Averett University must be in the major field.
  - a) Credits are not normally transferred from proprietary schools or from nonaccredited colleges.
  - b) Averett will accept courses from regionally accredited institutions of higher education for which a grade of C or higher was received. For those students who have received an associate's degree, Averett will accept in transfer all courses that were credited by the transferring institution toward the student's degree. **THE ONLY EXCEPTION TO THAT POLICY IS THAT AVERETT DOES NOT TRANSFER GRADES OF D ON COLLEGE COMPOSITION I OR II.**
  - c) Official copies of all Advanced Placement and CLEP scores should be sent directly from the testing agency to Averett.
2. The final 33 semester hours of academic work prior to graduation must be taken at Averett University.

### **MATHEMATICS**

All new students must take a mathematics placement test unless they have successfully completed a college mathematics course that is transferable as MTH 103, MTH 111 or higher or have received AP credit for MTH 103 or higher.

1. The placement test will help determine whether a student is placed in MTH 100, MTH 103 or higher.
2. If a student is placed in MTH 151 or MTH 201 and elects to take a lower level mathematics course, the student will receive credit for it but the course will not satisfy a general education requirement in mathematics.

3. Students who are required to take MTH 100 may not use those hours to satisfy the minimum of 123 hours for graduation.
4. All students must attain a mathematics proficiency level of MTH 103 or MTH 112. All students enrolled in a Business program must attain a mathematics proficiency level of MTH 171.
5. All students seeking licensure in Elementary Education must take MTH 111 and 112; therefore, if a student seeking this licensure is placed in MTH 103, 151 or 201, the student will take MTH 111 and 112.

## **ENGLISH**

ENG 316, Mythology and ENG 470, Children's Literature, do not satisfy the General Education requirement for literature.

Transfer students are encouraged to take the writing proficiency exam during their first semester at Averett.

## **TAKING COURSEWORK AT ANOTHER COLLEGE WHILE ENROLLED AT AVERETT UNIVERSITY**

After matriculation at Averett, all students who wish to receive credit for courses taken at another regionally accredited institution must receive written approval granted in advance from the Registrar. The written approval must be in the student's file in the Registrar's Office before credit will be given. Students must earn a grade of C or better in order to receive transfer credit for any course taken at another institution.

Grades on courses taken at another institution will not be calculated into the student's grade point average at Averett. Thus, courses taken elsewhere will neither raise nor lower the student's GPA. Academic work from all institutions will be considered in computing the final GPA for honors at graduation, but no overall average may exceed the one earned by a student at Averett.
