## SUNY Fredonia-Herkimer County Community College Articulation Agreement in Communication

By this agreement, students who complete the Associate in Applied Science in Radio-Television Broadcasting at Herkimer County Community College are guaranteed admission with full junior standing to the Bachelor of Science in Communication degree program at SUNY Fredonia. By completing the AAS degree and a minimum of 7/10 SUNY General Education requirements at Herkimer, such students will be able to complete their BS degree at SUNY Fredonia within 4 additional-full time semesters, taking a minimum of 15 credits per semester.

## **Major Options**

Audio/Radio Production Communication Studies Media Management Public relations Television and Digital Film Design and Production

**GPA Criteria:** To be guaranteed admission, students must have a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 or higher.

**SUNY General Education Categories:** This is referred to as the College Core Curriculum (CCC) at Fredonia. Students must complete a minimum of 7 of the required 10 courses. Furthermore:

- 1) Students are required to complete 2 courses in two different prefixes in the social sciences.
- 2) Students are required to complete 2 courses in two different prefixes in the natural sciences.
- 3) The CCC includes a speaking intensive requirement. This will be fulfilled if students complete the basic communication requirement at Herkimer.
- 4) The CCC also includes a 6 credit upper-level requirement which will be waived for students completing the BS in Communication. The BS in Communication requires completion of a minor which satisfies the upper-level requirement. Students may also satisfy this requirement with an approved study abroad experience. Please refer to the Fredonia College Catalog for detailed information on approved minors.
