

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

for

Business Administration

Between
J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College (JSRCC)
And
Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU)

For Students planning to pursue Accounting, Business Administration and Management, Economics, Finance, Human Resource Management, Information Systems, Marketing, and Real Estate and Land Development at VCU

Purpose: This memorandum of understanding has been developed within the framework of the Virginia State Policy on Transfer to facilitate the transfer of credits earned by students with Associate of Science (A.S.) Degrees in Business Administration credits at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College into Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree programs in Business at Virginia Commonwealth University. It is intended to provide students enrolled in the Business Administration A.S. program at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College admission into the baccalaureate business programs (with the exception of Financial Technology) at Virginia Commonwealth University. This agreement establishes a partnership between JSRCC and VCU for the benefit of students. This agreement updates and supersedes the Articulation Agreement between JSRCC and VCU signed on November 24, 1997.

JSRCC will advertise this program to the general public within the JSRCC service area. The program will be promoted as the "Business Administration Associate of Science Transfer Degree Program" in the JSRCC catalog, registration schedules of classes and other promotional materials. Representatives of JSRCC and VCU will call attention to this articulation agreement when advising students.

Courses listed in this program will be reviewed, as needed, by the faculty of both institutions to ensure continuity of instruction, curriculum, and evaluation. The attached "Business Administration Transfer Program Table" lists the respective transfer credits that will be awarded by VCU for courses offered by JSRCC students for transfer. This table will be updated as curricula evolve. There is a limit of 63 credits that may be transferred from JSRCC to VCU and course equivalency and transfer credits should be limited to those courses required for the student's selected major.

VCU School of Business will guarantee admission into its B.S. programs with junior standing (Accounting, Business Administration and Management, Economics, Finance, Human Resource Management, Information Systems, Marketing, and Real Estate and

Land Development) those students in the JSRCC transfer option who have completed the Associate Degree in Business Administration and who have a minimum curriculum grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale and no individual course grade lower than "C."

VCU will consider admission into its B.S. Business Foundation program, JSRCC curricular Business Administration A.S. program students who have not completed the A.S. program.


Transfer may occur at any time during the above-prescribed course of study at JSRCC. However, the course equivalencies as stated in the Business Administration Transfer Program Table are based on the completion of the Business Administration A.S. degree program prior to transfer. Students who transfer prior to the completion of the Business Administration A.S. degree program will have their courses evaluated individually per the VCU Transfer Guide Book. Therefore, students are encouraged to complete the Business Administration A.S. degree prior to matriculating to VCU.

Students can transfer credits back to JSRCC from VCU.

The partnership between VCU and JSRCC will include further development of courses.
