

Entrepreneurship Program Articulation with BMCC

The Baruch College BBA degree requires a minimum of 62 liberal arts credits and 62 business credits. Students with the Associates Degree in Entrepreneurship from BMCC will need approximately 64 credits from Baruch in order to earn the BBA degree.

I. Liberal Arts 62 credits required

Group I. Communications (12 credits)

BMCC students will have completely satisfied the 12 credits required here.

Group II. Mathematics and Statistics (7-9 credits)

BMCC students will receive 3 credits here for MAT 200 or 206. They will need to complete MTH 2006 and STA 2000 at Baruch.

Group III. Social and Behavioral Sciences (15- 16 credits)

BMCC students will have received 3 credits here for completion of ECO 201 or ECO 202.

Group IV. Humanities (12 credits)

No credit in this area for BMCC coursework.

Group V. Natural Science (4 credits)

This requirement will have been met at BMCC.

Group VI. Foreign Language (0-6 credits)

This requirement is waived for those students who completed two years of a modern language in high school or passed a two-year citywide or Regents examination.

Liberal Arts Elective (3-15)

BMCC students will receive 2 credits for HED 100.

II. Business Requirements 62 credits

BMCC students have 17 credits in this area. They must take:

BMCC students will receive 9 credits in this area and will need 15 more credits or two required major course and three major electives.
