B. Admission Requirements for Senior College Program

(e.g., minimum GPA, audition/portfolio):

- Bronx Community College (B.C.C.) graduates are exempt from all lower-division Lehman College General Education Degree Requirements.
- To earn the Bachelor's Degree at Lehman, CUNY Associate Degree graduates need to complete the courses required for the major / minor, two upper-division interdisciplinary courses, one writing intensive course, and elective courses if needed.
- BCC Students who transfer will have completed 55-59 of the 90 required State Education Department required Liberal Arts and Sciences Credits
- **BCC students must also complete the Lehman placement exam at B.C.C. and place into the 300-level Spanish courses**

36-CREDIT MAJOR IN SPANISH, B.A.

The required courses and credits are distributed as follows:

- 12 credits in required SPA courses: SPA 300, 306, 309, and 331
- 3 credits in one course in Latin American literature
- 3 credits in one course in Spanish literature
- 18 credits selected from 300- or 400-level SPA courses. PRS 302 or 303 (Puerto Rican Literature I or II) may be substituted for one of these courses. Students intending to do graduate work in Spanish should take at least 18 credits in literature.

Associate in Arts Degree from Bronx Community College.

Bronx Community College graduates with the Associate Degree in Liberal Arts and Sciences-Spanish Option will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Art in Spanish at Herbert H. Lehman College. In addition, they will be deemed to have met all lower division requirements at Bronx Community College.

E. Articulation Agreement Follow-Up Procedures

1. Procedures for reviewing, up-dating, modifying or terminating agreement:

Bronx Community College Modern Languages Department Chair, Dr. Jose Lopez-Marron , and Lehman Languages and Literature Chairperson, Dr. Maria DiPaolo, will review implementation of the agreement once every two years to ensure that students are adequately informed of the program and to identify issues requiring attention.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, e.g., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:

After transfer into the Lehman Spanish major, the performance of Bronx Community College students will be tracked using the CUNY Institutional Research Data Base. The Lehman Office of Institutional Research, Planning and Assessment will inform BCC about the academic progress of transfer students. Additionally, these students will be surveyed after graduation from Lehman to determine educational and occupational experience and success, and Lehman will share this information with BCC.

The Lehman College Spanish major faculty provide advisement to all students entering the major.

3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:

Notice of articulation will be placed in the respective catalogues, recruiting brochures, websites, and on the CUNY TIPPS website.

Respective transfer and academic advisers will be informed and provided with copies of this agreement.

The Lehman Department of Languages and Literature will coordinate efforts with Lehman's Admissions Office to make certain that materials are sent with recruitment officers for BCC's annual Transfer Day event.
