Computer Information Systems graduates may transfer to Life University's Computer Information Management program for a Bachelor of Science degree. A total of up to 105 quarter credit hours can transfer to Life University. 6 computer courses will transfer for a total transfer credit of 30 quarter hours. They are Computer Concepts, Programming Design and Development, Operating Systems, System Analysis and Design, Database Management, and Networking Fundamentals.

Advanced standing hours that can be used as a part of the 120 quarter hours in areas IV, V, VI and VII of the curriculum. There are 185 total program quarter hours.

If a student does not take a course or courses in the chart listed above then they must take the equivalent course or courses at Life University.

Due to the variety of industry specific courses at Griffin Tech College, some of which provide conceptual duplication across platforms, while other courses are stratified across introductory, intermediate, and advanced levels, Life University proposes using this "menu" approach to the transfer possibilities. Because some courses are 300 and 400 level and encompass a greater breadth and synthesis of managerial skill, a senior Management research Project may be required to augment the same course experience with greater breadth and depth of managerial perspective. Every combination of courses cannot be covered in this "menu" so other possibilities will be considered on an individual basis. These possibilities will be evaluated by the Business Department at Life University.

Life University will accept **up to** 105 quarter hours from Griffin Technical College. The student must then pass 80 quarter hours in designated courses with the appropriate GPA at Life University to receive the BS in CIM degree. In this way, the student can receive advanced standing when entering the program.
