Articulation Transfer Agreement in Fine Arts Photography

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transfer of students from Bucks County Community College Fine Arts to Savannah College of Art and Design Bachelor of Fine Arts Photography.

Conditions and Benefits

To qualify for this agreement, a student must:

- Complete the BCCC courses as listed in the agreement.
- Apply and be accepted to Savannah College of Art and Design.
- Follow requirements for portfolio review.
- Earn a grade of C or higher in all transferable courses.

For students who have followed the stated conditions:

BCCC courses will transfer as listed on the agreement.

A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD BFA program of study.

Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD.

- The courses listed are currently transferable under the 2007 SCAD course catalog for specific SCAD requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography.
- Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD. Students may choose to fulfill requirements of any subsequent SCAD course catalog within five years of their first enrollment at SCAD.
- This document is specific to the Bucks County Community College Fine Arts Transfer Major and the Savannah College of Art and Design's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography.
- In order for a class to be considered for transfer, it needs to be at least three semester credit hours or five quarter hours. A grade of "C" or higher must be earned in the class. A course transferred from the Bucks County Community College may fulfill only one SCAD course requirement.
- A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD BFA program of study.
- In some instances, a student's course selection may fulfill a different requirement than listed above. In those specific instances, it may be advantageous in the student's course of study to allow the course to fulfill a different requirement rather than a general education or free elective.
