- 2. For students participating in the Joint Admissions Program with SUNY Brockport, maintaining continuous study, achieving a minimum 2.5 GPA and successfully completing courses as specified in this advisement guide are required. Additional GPA requirements exist for Accounting (2.5 in specified prerequisite courses), Business Administration (2.5 in specified prerequisite courses), International Business (3.0 in specified prerequisite courses), Social Work (3.0) and education certification programs (3.0). If these conditions are not met, continued participation in the program and acceptance to SUNY Brockport will be in jeopardy
- 3. Completion of this course does not exempt students from the computer skills exam required by SUNY Brockport.
- 4. SUNY Brockport required a grade of at least "C" in each course used to satisfy an Interdisciplinary Arts for Children major requirement.
- 5. Arts for Children is an interdisciplinary major at SUNY Brockport, which requires study in art, dance, music, and theatre, with in depth study of one of these arts. Please refer to college catalog.
- 6. For acceptance into the Dance specialty, SUNY Brockport requires an entry audition. Contact the Department of Dance for information and application materials. Auditions are held in November, February, and April.
- 7. Students interested in teaching must submit a separate application to SUNY Brockport's teacher certification program. Applications for admission to teacher certification programs are due September 15th for spring admission and February 15th for fall admission. Specific coursework and minimum 2.5 GPA are required for acceptance into the program. For additional information, go to www.brockport.edu/ehd or SUNY Brockport's catalog.
- 8. SUNY Brockport requires students complete a minimum 30-hour experience working with children in a structured, academic setting in grades 1-6 prior to applying to the Childhood Education program
