Admissions Requirements

We hope to admit you to California State University, East Bay so you can share in this special educational opportunity. For admission to Cal State East Bay, you need to **meet our eligibility** standards and submit your application and the other required documents during the appropriate filing period. If you are a resident of a country other than the United States, you will need to meet some additional requirements.

The eligibility standards and the documents you will need to submit depend on whether you are entering as a first-time freshman, transfer student, or international undergraduate student. Eligibility Requirements

- You have completed **fewer** than 60 transferable semester (90 quarter) units
- You have a grade point average of 2.0 or better in all transferable units attempted
- You are in good standing at the last college or university attended
- You have met the admission requirements for first-time freshmen.

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Upper Division Transfer Admission

Eligibility Requirements

- You have completed a minimum of 60 transferable semester (90 quarter) units
- You have a grade point average of 2.0 or better in all transferable units attempted
- You are in good standing at the last college or university attended
- You have completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) units of college coursework with a grade of "C" or better in each course

The 30 semester (45 quarter) units must be selected from English, Arts and Humanities, Social Science, Science, and Mathematics at a level at least equivalent to courses that meet general education requirements.

The 30 (45 quarter) units must include all of the general education requirements in:

- Communication in the English language both oral communication & written communication (at least six semester units)
- Critical thinking (at least 3 semester units)
- Mathematics/quantitative reasoning (usually 3 semester units)
- the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) requirements in English communication and mathematical concepts & quantitative reasoning

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
