

Transfer Requirements

Every applicant must submit an admissions application and a \$50 application fee. Every admitted student who intends to enroll must submit a \$100 acceptance deposit. Upon orientation students must submit a \$50 orientation fee. The application fee, acceptance deposit, and orientation fee are non-refundable.

All freshman and transfer students with fewer than 16 college credits must submit SAT or ACT test scores.

Transfer students must submit official transcripts from all colleges attended to the Office of Enrollment Management. Transfers with fewer than 16 transfer credits at the date of application must provide official high school transcripts or, if a high school equivalency certificate (GED) is possessed, equivalency test scores and high school transcripts for years attended. Transfers with 16 or more transfer credits who have not attained an associate's degree at the date of application must provide a copy of the high school diploma or, if a GED is possessed, equivalency test scores and transcripts from years attended.

Students graduating from a New Jersey county/community college with an AA/AS degree in a Stockton-approved transfer program may be granted up to a maximum of 64 credits upon notification of acceptance. An associate in applied science (AAS) degree is not generally transferrable and is evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

Transfer students from four-year institutions may transfer up to 96 credits. In order to graduate from Stockton with a bachelor's degree, transfers must take a minimum of 32 credits at Stockton.
