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I. CREDIT BY PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION

- Proficiency credit is recorded on the student transcript using the grading mode of "CR."
- Proficiency credit is limited by the College Residency Requirement. At least half of the student's credits must be earned through Genesee Community College courses, including 24 of the final 30 hours. Credit earned through proficiency examination is not considered credit in residence, nor is it used in calculating a grade point average (GPA).
- Examinations may not be taken by students who have taken the equivalent course work.
- Students must accumulate six semester hours of credit in residence before proficiency credit is recorded on the student transcript.
- Credit earned for any proficiency examinations is given to registered (now accepted) Genesee Community College students only.

A. Internal Examinations

The fee is paid prior to testing. A student who does not pass an examination for credit in a particular course will not be permitted to retake the examination.

II. PREAPPROVED CREDIT FOR PREVIOUS TRAINING

The evaluation of credit for previous training involves a review of the student's supporting documentation. There is a transcribing fee for each evaluation.

- Credit for previous training is recorded on the student transcript using the grading mode of "CR."
- Credit for previous training is limited by the College Residency Requirement. At least half of the student's credits must be earned through Genesee Community College courses, including 24 of the final 30 hours. Credit for previous training is not considered credit in residence, nor is it used in calculating a grade point average (GPA).
- Students must accumulate six semester hours of credit in residence before credit for previous training is recorded on the student transcript.
- Credit earned for any preapproved training is given to registered Genesee Community College students only.

A. Basic Police Training

Students who have successfully completed the New York State Basic Course for Police Officers are eligible to receive credit for the following courses:

CRJ 101, CRJ 110, CRJ 112, CRJ 160, CRJ 206, CRJ 222, HED 205, and PED 132

TRANSCRIPTING FEE: Equivalent amount for one credit hour at \$136 for a total of 22 credits.

B. Child Development Associate (CDA)

Students with a current CDA Certificate awarded by the Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition are eligible to receive credit for the following courses:

TRANSCRIPTING FEE: Equivalent amount for one credit hour at \$136 for a total of nine (9) credits.

C. The National Program on Noncollegiate Sponsored Instruction (PONSI)

TRANSCRIPTING FEE: Equivalent amount for one credit hour of \$136 per course.

2. Other PED credit is *considered* when evaluating student requests for previous training credit for physical education, such as:

- Documented experience as a head or assistant coach in the activity.
- Documented higher-level participation such as Olympics, Junior Olympics, or three or more years of intercollegiate participation.
- Superior expertise as evidenced by being classified at the instructor level, and/or with appropriate evidence of current certification at the instructor and/or expertise level. Examples might include an instructional expert skier or a black belt in the martial arts.

EVALUATION FEE (NONREFUNDABLE): \$30.00 per course

TRANSCRIPTING FEES, IF APPROVED: Equivalent amount for one-half of the current per in-state tuition credit charge of \$136; therefore, \$68 for each credit awarded.

III. CREDIT FOR LIFE EXPERIENCE

A thorough evaluation of a student's documentation of previous training or life experience must be completed to determine if credit may be awarded.

- Life experience credit is recorded on the student transcript using the grading mode of "CR."
- Credit earned for any life experience is given to registered Genesee Community College students only.

EVALUATION FEE (NONREFUNDABLE): \$30.00 per course

A student may petition for credit for courses for which no previous college credit has been earned and no local proficiency examinations exist. The student is expected to demonstrate proficiencies equal to or exceeding the performance standards in the course outline. The student must provide a portfolio of materials that document the proficiencies. A faculty evaluator and dean evaluate the student's documentation and make recommendations for credit. They may recommend credit, recommend credit contingent on further demonstration of student proficiencies, or deny credit.

Credit awarded through the Credit for Life Experience process must be for a specific course listed in the Genesee Community College catalog, and must be applicable to the student's major.

TRANSCRIPTING FEES, IF APPROVED: Equivalent amount of one-half of the current in-state tuition charge of \$136; therefore, \$68 for each credit awarded.

IV. MILITARY EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Credit for military work is recorded on the student transcript using the grading mode of "TR."
- Credit for military experience is limited by the College Residency Requirement. At least half of the student's credits must be earned through Genesee Community College courses, including 24 of the final 30 hours. Credit for military experience is not considered credit in residence, nor is it used in calculating a grade point average (GPA).
- Students may earn credit for their military experience. Documentation of the student's Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) or Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) along with other military academic records must be provided, and a review is made using the "Guide to Evaluation of Military Experiences in the Armed Services" published by the American Council on Education.
- Two credits of physical education elective may be awarded by presenting a copy of form DD-214 to the Advisement Center.
- Credit earned for any military education and experience is given to registered Genesee Community College students only.
