ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

(you must complete each step to enroll at Northark)

- I. An admission application completed online at: http://www.northark.edu/future_students/admissions/application_for_admission.aspx
- 2. An official transcript from each college or university attended
- 3. Documentation on file:
 - Placement test (ACT, ASSET, or COMPASS) scores

- Official CLEP and AP Scores (if applicable)
- 4. Proof of two MMR (measles, mumps & rubella) immunizations



TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

- **Grants** do not have to be paid back unless you withdraw completely and owe a refund.
- Loans must be paid back.
- Workstudy on campus work program to earn money.
- <u>Scholarships</u> various requirements for each scholarship. Check with the financial aid office about requirements for each.

Official transcripts must be on file and evaluated to receive financial aid.

Tuition (due by specific date each semester)


