ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

(you must complete each step to enroll at Northark)

1. An admission application completed online at:
http://www.northark.edu/future_students/admissions/application_for_admission.aspx
2. An official transcript from each college or university attended
3. Documentation on file:
 - Placement test (ACT, ASSET, or COMPASS) scores
 - Visit the link below to arrange to take tests:

 - Official CLEP and AP Scores (if applicable)
4. Proof of two MMR (measles, mumps & rubella) immunizations



TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

- **Grants** - do not have to be paid back unless you withdraw completely and owe a refund.
- **Loans** - must be paid back.
- **Workstudy** – on campus work program to earn money.
- **Scholarships** – various requirements for each scholarship. Check with the financial aid office about requirements for each.



HOW TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

(4 – 6 Week Process)

- 1.** Visit Educational Opportunity Center (EOC)

- 2.** Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - go to www.fafsa.ed.gov
 - be sure to use Northark's School Code **012261**
- 3.** Visit Northark Financial Aid Office
 - 870-391-3266
 - www.northark.edu/financialaid/default.aspx

Official transcripts must be on file and evaluated to receive financial aid.

(tuition is the cost of attendance at Northark)

 - An award letter is required if using financial aid for tuition payment.
- * Tuition is due by a specific date.**
- If payment or **awarded** financial aid is not in place by this date, classes will be dropped.

- After your application is received and accepted by us, you will receive an acceptance letter with more information about Northark, including instructions on how to schedule an appointment with a Northark Advisor.
- *Student ID number, username, and password for Northark technology will be **re-issued** when you attend your first advising appointment.*

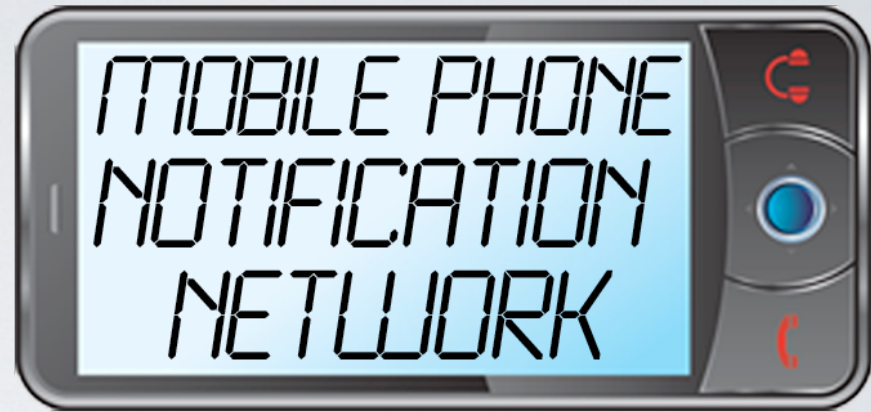



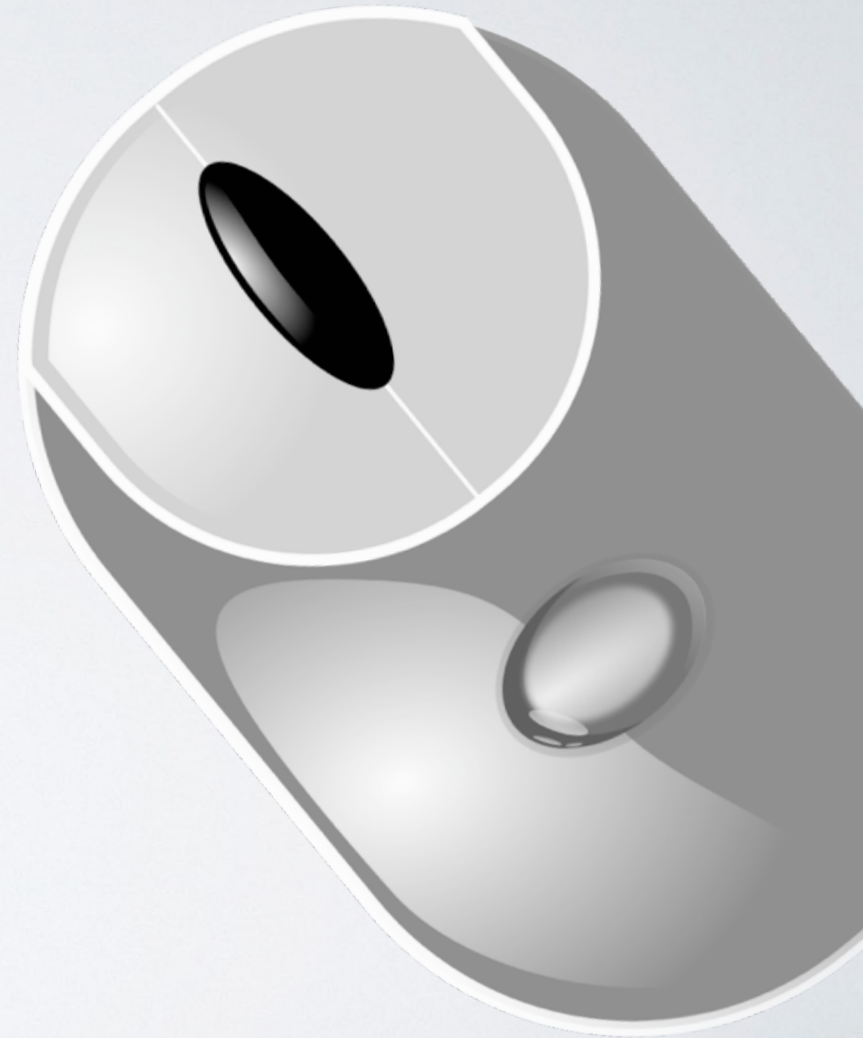

Tuition (due by specific date each semester)

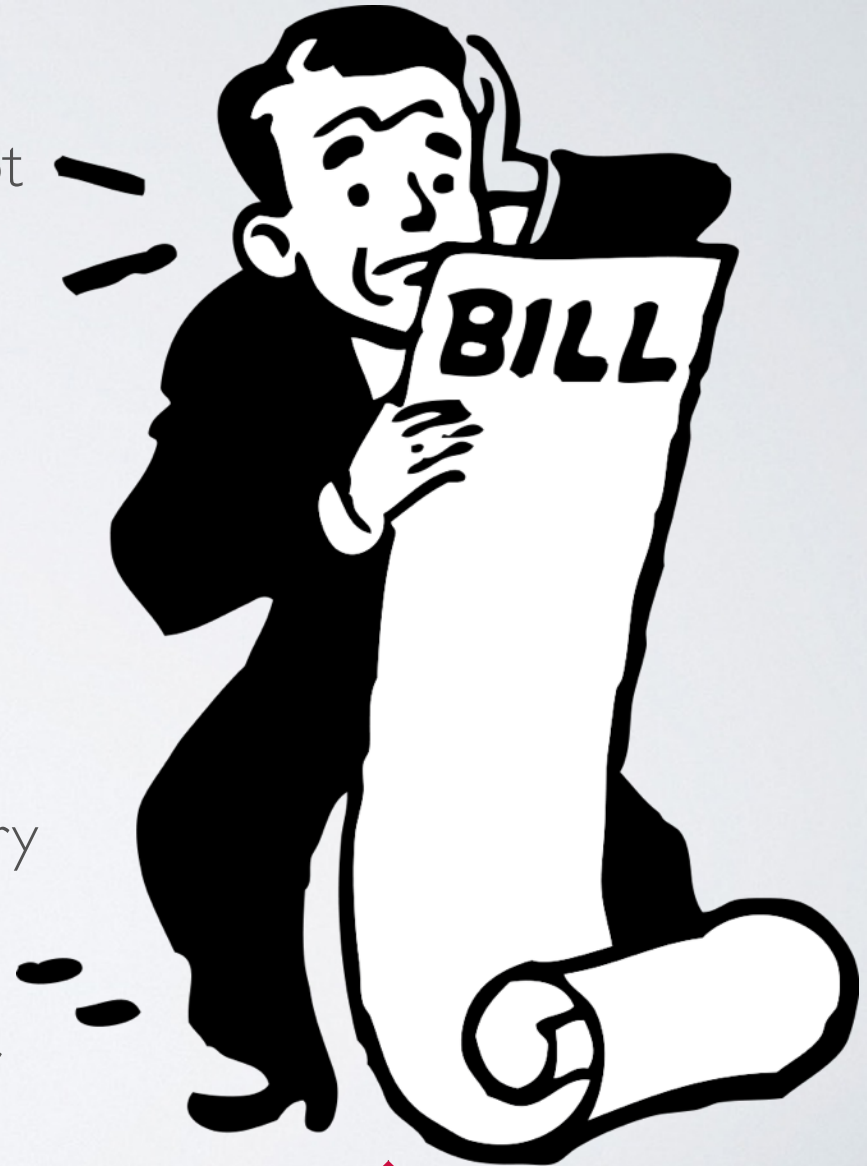
- If payment or **awarded** financial aid is not in place, classes will be dropped.
