



Transfer Students

Augustana annually attracts approximately 100 transfer students from a wide range of post secondary institutions: public universities, private colleges, community colleges, and junior colleges. We welcome the opportunity to build upon what you have learned thus far and provide you with an exceptional academic and student life experience preparing you well for a rewarding professional and personal life.

Since each transfer student brings a unique set of academic credentials and career goals, it is important to make an appointment to visit personally with our Director of Admission, Adam Heinitz (adam.heinitz@augie.edu). He will review your previous coursework and provide an evaluation indicating how your college [credits will transfer](#) and the approximate time it will take you to complete a program of study at Augustana.

Transfer of Credits

In general, if you have been enrolled in an associate or baccalaureate degree program at an accredited college or university and possess a minimum grade point average of 2.25 (4.0 scale), you will be considered for admission. Credit will normally be accepted at Augustana from a college or university offering Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Bachelor of Arts, or a Bachelor of Science and holds accreditation from any one of the following regional accrediting agencies of schools and colleges:

Lecture and lab courses taken at an accredited college or university will be transcribed at Augustana. Only courses in which the student earned a C- or better are eligible for transfer credit. Any credit(s) not used toward major or general education core requirements will be treated as an elective. The actual number of credits accepted for the major will be determined by the appropriate department chairperson. Students must complete a minimum of 30 hours of coursework at Augustana to receive a degree.

If your coursework includes any credit obtained through the College Level Examination Program (CLEP), Augustana will grant credit provided those credits were from the CLEP Subject Examinations. You may earn as many as 32 semester credit hours (one full year) through satisfactory completion of these exams.
