

# Transfer Credit

Upon acceptance, transfer students receive a credit evaluation indicating which classes have transferred, along with a curriculum summary identifying the courses required for a bachelor's degree at Bryant.

- Up to 62 credits from a two-year college and 92 credits from a four-year college may be accepted for transfer credit.
- Courses in which a student receives a grade of "C" or better are transferrable, as long as the courses fit into the Bryant curriculum.
- Certain courses may require faculty approval before credit can be awarded.
