

Transfer Student Graduation

Transfer students shall be granted the AA, AS, AE, or AAS degree if either the last 15 credits prior to receiving their degree or a total of 50 credits are taken at CSI. CSI accepts transfer credits from other postsecondary institutions accredited by a postsecondary regional accrediting agency or state approval agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as a “reliable authority as to the quality of postsecondary education” within the meaning of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. However, each student's transcript is evaluated on an individual basis. Conversely, courses taken at CSI should transfer to other two-year and four-year colleges and universities.

Transfer students who have completed the general education core courses from any regionally accredited institution but have not received a degree will not be required to take additional lower-division general education core courses. However, these students must provide official certification of completion of the general education core from the transferring institution to the College of Southern Idaho.
