

Transferring Credits to EPCC

El Paso Community College will accept transfer credits from any college or university accredited through a recognized regional accrediting association. The college is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and is required to have transcripts for each student from all institutions previously attended. This requirement is mandated by SACS in order for EPCC to maintain its accreditation.

EPCC follows the prescribed SACS policies for acceptance of transfer credit. Generally, credit will be accepted for any college level non-remedial course in which you receive a “D” (or equivalent) or better. Quarter credit hours will be converted to semester credits using a two-thirds ratio, i.e., three quarter credit hours will be converted to two semester credit hours.

Even if you do not plan to complete a degree at EPCC, you will need to submit all transcripts for Texas Success Initiative compliance and academic advising. Where applicable, transcripts will be evaluated for undergraduate credit and transferred to your current EPCC transcript. Upper division and graduate courses do not transfer.

Transfer of credits from a foreign college or university also follow SACS guidelines. Original transcripts must be provided by the student to recognized credentials evaluation agency. You may contact the Admissions and Registration Office for detailed information.
