TRANSFERRING CREDITS TO ICC

ICC provides for the evaluation and transfer of prior post-secondary education credit to ICC. Courses completed at other accredited colleges and universities are transferable to ICC through our Registrar's office. Programs of study completed at state-accredited technical or vocational schools are also recognized and transferable to ICC, in accordance with the equivalency formula mandated by the Kansas State Board of Education, acting in concert with the Dean of Instruction and/or division chairs as needed. Course work completed at non-accredited or proprietary schools shall be similarly considered for possible transfer by the Registrar, acting in consultation with the Dean of Instruction.

The college offers a comprehensive academic program parallel to the freshman and sophomore requirements for baccalaureate degrees in four-year institutions. A student transferring to a four-year institution should study that institution's college catalog, and consult with his/her faculty advisor and enroll in college courses that satisfy transfer requirements.
