Transfer Credit Evaluations

Transfer Credit Evaluations, under the Office of the Registrar, evaluates all transfer credits, advanced placement, and non-traditional credits posted to student's academic records. Articulation tables and program information that can be found on u.select are maintained to assist students in reviewing / previewing transfer credit information.

What credits transfer?

Transfer credit is granted for college-level courses earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education for which you receive a grade of a "C" or better. Transfer credit will be granted in any course taken **Fall 2009** or after in which the grade reported was a D- or better from a regionally accredited **Ohio**institution. Transfer credit will be granted in any course taken **Fall 2010** or after in which the grade reported was a D- or better from **all** regionally accredited institutions.

Do my grades transfer?

Grades do not transfer and do not affect your Miami GPA.

What credit will I receive for my AP / IB / CLEP scores?

Advanced Placement credit is posted to students records from the AP Student Grade Report.

 - How do hours transfer for quarter and semester schools?
 - Only the credits earned transfer to Miami.
 - Please note:
 - Credits earned at a semester school transfer intact to Miami. Credits earned at a quarter school transfer to Miami at 2/3 the earned value:
 - 5.0 qtr hrs = 3.3 sem hrs
 - 4.0 qtr hrs = 2.6 sem hrs
 - 3.0 qtr hrs = 2.0 sem hrs
 - 2.0 gtr hrs = 1.3 sem hrs
