## **Transfer from Other Post-Secondary Educational Institutions**

Students may be admitted as transfer students from other colleges. The standard admission requirements remain the same as those for first-time college students. Students must indicate all previous colleges, vocational, and post secondary schools attended on their application for admission to NTC. Official transcripts must be in a sealed envelope and mailed directly from the institution to the NTC Admissions/Registrar's Office.

Note: Transfer courses are not included in calculating the student's NTC cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA). Students who were placed on Academic Suspension will be referred to the Academic Counselor and recommendation of admission.

## **Transfer Credit**

College credits earned at regionally accredited institutions of higher learning are accepted. Credits are not awarded for sectarian courses. Transfer credits are posted on the transcript after an official evaluation is made of each transcript received by the Registrar's office. Credits over ten (10) years of age (except when program accreditation agencies limit the life of the course work to less than ten years) are subject to review prior to acceptance toward prerequisites and/or degree 8 requirements in some program areas. Transfer credit will be awarded for each college course level in which the student received a grad of —Cll or higher.

## **Military Credit Evaluation**

Credit for military service is granted based on recommendation of the American Council of Education's —Guide to the Evaluation of Educational Experiences in the armed Servicell and institutional policies. No credit is granted for Military Occupational Specialty (MOS). To apply for military credit, submit a copy of the DD214 and a copy of any applicable training not listed on the DD214 to the Registrar's Office. The Veteran's certifying official is located in the Financial Aid Office, 505/786-4183.
