TRANSFER CREDIT

Credit that has been successfully completed at other US accredited institutions (including Running Start credits) may be transferred to NCAD if transfer situations meet the following:

- **A.** Studio art classes must have been completed within the last 10 years. (There is no time limit on general education classes).
- **B.** Classes must be comparable with NCAD classes.
- **C.** Class grade is a C+ or above.
- **D.** Applicant can demonstrate appropriate skill.
- **E.** Transfer class credit is equal to or above NCAD class credit.

Official transcript of grades and course outlines must be presented no later than August 1st for evaluation. Transfer credit will not be granted after the August 1st deadline. A portfolio evaluation may be required. No more than 50% of the program may transfer. Transferring credit may reduce program length, however reduction is not guaranteed. Transferring credit may require the student to drop to a part-time status at certain times during the program.

Credit is not available for life experience. Standard High school courses other than AP or Running Start classes do not apply. Advanced Placement (AP) credits taken in high school and evaluated by The College Board will be evaluated for transfer credit
