Grades Acceptable for Course Transfer

The Alamo Colleges accept any passing grade from any accredited institution. Passing is a grade of "D" or better. Only those courses in which a "D" or better has been earned may be applied to meet the requirements toward a certificate or degree, and only those technical courses in which a "C" or better has been earned may be applied to meet the requirements in the major field of study. This policy applies to all degree plans.
