

**What credits are accepted by Quinnipiac?**

Credits earned at a regionally accredited college or university with a grade of C or better that are similar to courses offered at Quinnipiac will usually transfer. (Most courses at Quinnipiac are three credits - exceptions in lab sciences are clearly marked in the University catalog.) Transfer students who have earned AP credit in high school must provide official scores for review. Unofficial evaluations of credit are provided after admission, although prospective students may request an evaluation prior to applying. Official acceptance of transfer credit is completed when a student accepts an offer of admission to a program of study.
