## Admission of Transfer Students

Prospective students who wish to transfer credit from another institution should follow the admission procedure outlined above. Additionally, during the application process, they must provide Summit Christian College with an official transcript of credit from all previous institutions attended. After evaluating all transcripts, the Registrar's Office will inform transfer students of the number of credit hours and required courses they need to take for their degree program. Summit Christian College will not apply transfer credit until the official transcripts have been received and evaluated by the registrar's office and the student has enrolled in classes. Summit Christian College will not accept transfer credits for courses with a grade below a 2.0.

Students transferring in credit must take a minimum of 32 semester hours of credit for the B.S./B.A. or 16 semester hours of credit for the A.A. from SCC in order to receive their degree. Summit Christian College does not accept students who have outstanding bills at other colleges.
