

Transfer Course Equivalency Guide

Many of UST's core requirements can be taken at other institutions. The Course Equivalency Guide listed below provides parallels that can be taken at two-year colleges. No course with a grade lower than "C" (GPA 2.0) will be accepted for transfer. UST will accept up to 72 hours from two-year colleges.

Transfer Credit Evaluation Guidelines

Many of UST's core requirements can be taken at other institutions. The Course Equivalency Guide provides parallels that can be taken at two-year colleges.

- No course with a grade lower than "C" (GPA 2.0) will be accepted for transfer.
- UST will accept up to 72 hours from two-year colleges or 90 from 4 year institution. A maximum of 90 transferable credit hours may be applied to degree plan.
- Students Must take 36 hours in residence at UST unless academic committee grants exception.

UST does not accept the following course credit

- Vocational or occupational training
- Developmental /Remedial study skill course
- Courses from college/university which do not have regional accreditation
